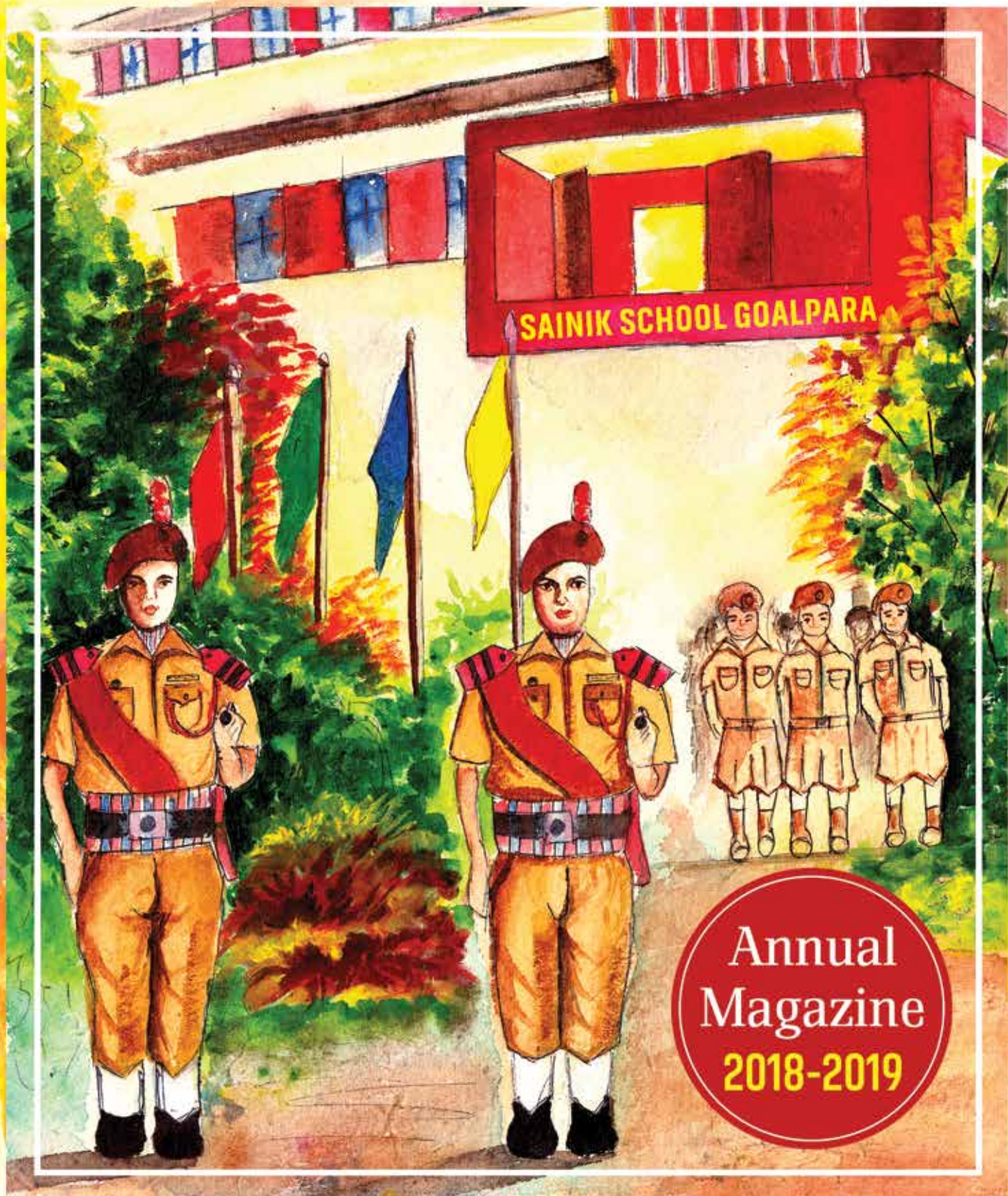

THE PATH TRODDEN

OVERVIEW OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19

Academic Year 2018-19 has been a very significant one with remarkable achievements in diverse arenas including academics, sports and games, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Academics.

The school has performed exceedingly well despite hectic schedules and numerous participation in inter-house as well as inter-school sports and co-curricular competitions, both at state and national level. The school achieved 100% results in Class X & XII Board Examinations. In class XII, 07 out of 43 cadets secured above 75%. Cdt Aaditya Rohan & Cdt Sateesh Kumar topped the class with 87.80%.

Various initiatives have been instituted for academic and learning enhancement viz.

- UPSC preparatory classes for Class XII Mathematics conducted by experts from Guwahati.
- UPSC Mock Tests on Mathematics, Intelligence and Reasoning were conducted every Wednesday and Friday for class XI and XII.
- Daily presentation and talks on topics of importance for class XI and XII.
- Cadets were given exposure to various competitive examinations including International/ National Maths, Science, Cyber and English Olympiads.

Personality Development.

Various motivational talks, interactive sessions, workshops were organised to strengthen the personality of cadets :

- 16 cadets participated in workshops on Ethical Hacking, Artificial Intelligence, Android Application Development and Bluetooth Robotics in the Annual Techno Management



Festival at IIT Guwahati in Aug 18.

- Cadets of SSG as well as 100 girls from local schools of Dudhnoi & Goalpara attended the presentation and interacted with the lady officers of the Navy who participated in the Navika Sagar Parikrama Expedition in Sep 18.
- Two Chess Workshops were organized in Mar and Sep 18 at SSG by Chess experts from Assam Chess Association.
- Class XI cadets attended a three day Youth Care Programme at Don Bosco Institute Guwahati in Nov 18.
- Class XII cadets were trained in GTO tasks by Wg Cdr M K Shrivastav, GTO, A F Selection Centre, Dehradun in Nov 18.

Teachers' Training.

- Two teachers and Librarian attended the All India Sainik



Schools Teachers' Workshop at SS Kodagu in May 18.

- Four teachers attended the "Capacity Building Programme" at St Xavier's School, Krishnai, and four teachers participated in "Examination and Evaluation 2019" workshop conducted at Royal Global School, Guwahati.
- Two teachers participated in the Regional Maths Workshop at Regional Science Centre in Feb 19.

Sports.

This year augured well for SSG in the field of sports. The achievements in various sports is unparalleled.

- SSG hosted the East Zone Championship in Jul 18 and stood champions.
- SSG Basketball Team participated in CBSE Cluster-I at



Miles Bronson Residential School, Guwahati and stood first. They participated in the CBSE National Basketball Tournament held at John Milton Public School, Agra.

- SSG Hockey Team participated in AISS Inter Zonal Hockey Championship held at SS Chittorgarh and stood runners up. The team participated in CBSE Far East Zone Hockey Championship held at O P Jindal School Rajgarh, Chhattisgarh and stood first. The team stood runners up in the CBSE National Hockey Tournament held at Gurunanak School, Ludhiana, Punjab in Nov 18. It is for the first time, SSG reached the finals in CBSE Hockey.
- SSG Volleyball team participated in the AISS Inter Zonal Volleyball Championship held at SS Kodagu and stood runners up. The team won the CBSE Cluster 1 Volleyball Championship at Kaziranga English Academy, Guwahati and participated in CBSE National at Sangrur, Punjab in Nov 18.
- SSG U-17 Football Team participated in AISS Inter Zonal Football Championship held at SS Ghorakhal. U-14 Football team of SSG emerged as defending champion in IPSC Soccer tournament held at Miles Bronson Residential School, Guwahati and represented IPSC Schools in prestigious Suburoto Cup held in New Delhi. Two cadets played Suburto Cup 2018 for NCC Football team from North East Directorate.
- SSG hosted an eight day camp in Nov 18 for IPSC Football team (U-14). 18 players from ten different schools from all over India, including three cadets form SSG, practised and participated in the Championship at JNV Kokrajhar in Nov 18.

Co-Curricular Activities.

Various IH Co-curricular competitions including Debate, Essay Writing and Story Writing in English, Hindi & Assamese, IH Quiz and Art competitions were conducted. In addition, the cadets brought laurels by participating in various events outside:-

- Participated in “9th Manas Borah Memorial Inter-Institutional Debate competition” and “Bilas Barua Choudhury Memorial Essay Writing Competition” conducted by OBA, SSG in May 18.
- SSG Quiz team won the “Mera Desh Mahaan” Inter School Quiz Competition held at Goalpara in Aug 18.
- Participated in Lady Anusuiya Singhania Memorial All India English & Hindi Debate contest at L K Singhania Education Centre, Gotan, Rajasthan in Aug 18.
- Stood 2nd in the school quiz organised by Down Town University at Guwahati.



- Participated for the first time in the IPSC Dance Competition at Assam Valley School, Tezpur in Aug 18.
- Participated in “Bharat Ko Jano Quiz” at state level in Oct 18 and won second position in both senior and junior category.
- Three cadets participated in the DST-Inspire Science camp 2018 held at NIT Silchar on 09 Dec 18. Cdt Satyam Kumar of class XI was awarded first position in the Essay writing competition.
- In the maiden online participation in “Clash of Pi Series 3 Online Mathematics Contest” organised by the “The Hindu” in Jul 18, one cadet secured 20th position & twelve cadets secured 90 percentile at all India basis.

Educational / Motivational Tours.

Seeing is believing and a great deal of learning takes place by visiting places of historical, cultural and religious significance. Over the years, SSG has been able to send cadets to various places of interest. Class VI visited the Regional Science Centre and Observatory at Guwahati; Class VII visited Shillong; Class VIII visited Kaziranga National Park and 618 AD Brigade; Class IX visited INS Chilka for Watermanship Training and Bhubaneswar; Class XI visited the National Defence Academy to witness the Passing Out Parade and also visited Naval Dockyard and ships and submarines at Mumbai; Class XII visited Air Force Station, Borjhar.

In addition, 40 cadets (IX) visited Delhi and Rajasthan. Cdt Mayank Kumar and Cdt Abhishek Gautam of class X completed AISS Mountaineering Expedition at Ladakhi Peak in Himachal Pradesh in May 18.

Under the banner of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat, focussing on the theme of unity in diversity, SSG cadets visited SS Chittorgarh in Apr 18. SSG hosted the cadets of SS Chittorgarh in Nov 18.



They were shown a cultural bonanza put together by the staff and cadets of SSG as well as children of Nirmala High School. In addition, 10 cadets and a teacher participated in Central Sainik Schools Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Mahotsava from 29-31 Jan 19 at Sainik School Bijapur, Karnataka.

School Celebrations.

The various celebrations on the occasion of birthdays and memorial days along with House Days bring in lot of cheer. Of late, SSG is roping in various organisations in celebrating national days in the school.

- ➔ World Environment Day was celebrated on 4 Jun 18 in collaboration with Rain Forest Research Institute, Jorhat. A student rally from SSG to Mornai and Nepalikhuti was organised. Cadets of SSG and students of local schools participated in painting competition, slogan writing competition, Debate, Quiz and Extempore Speech to commemorate the event.

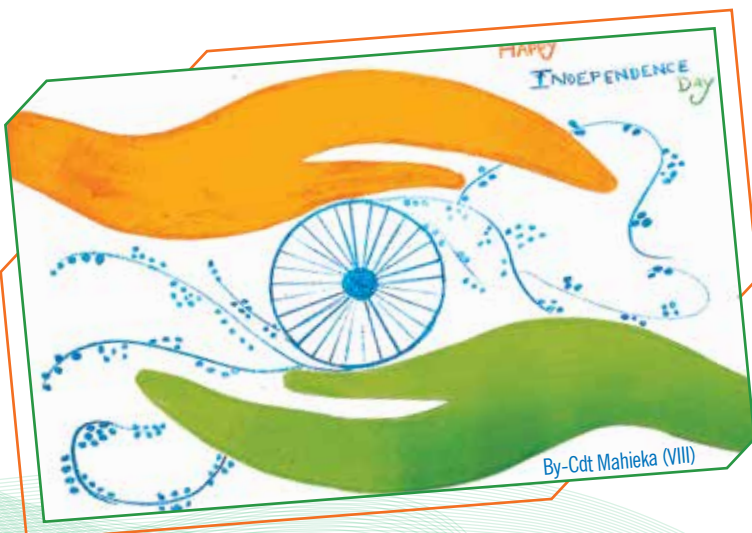

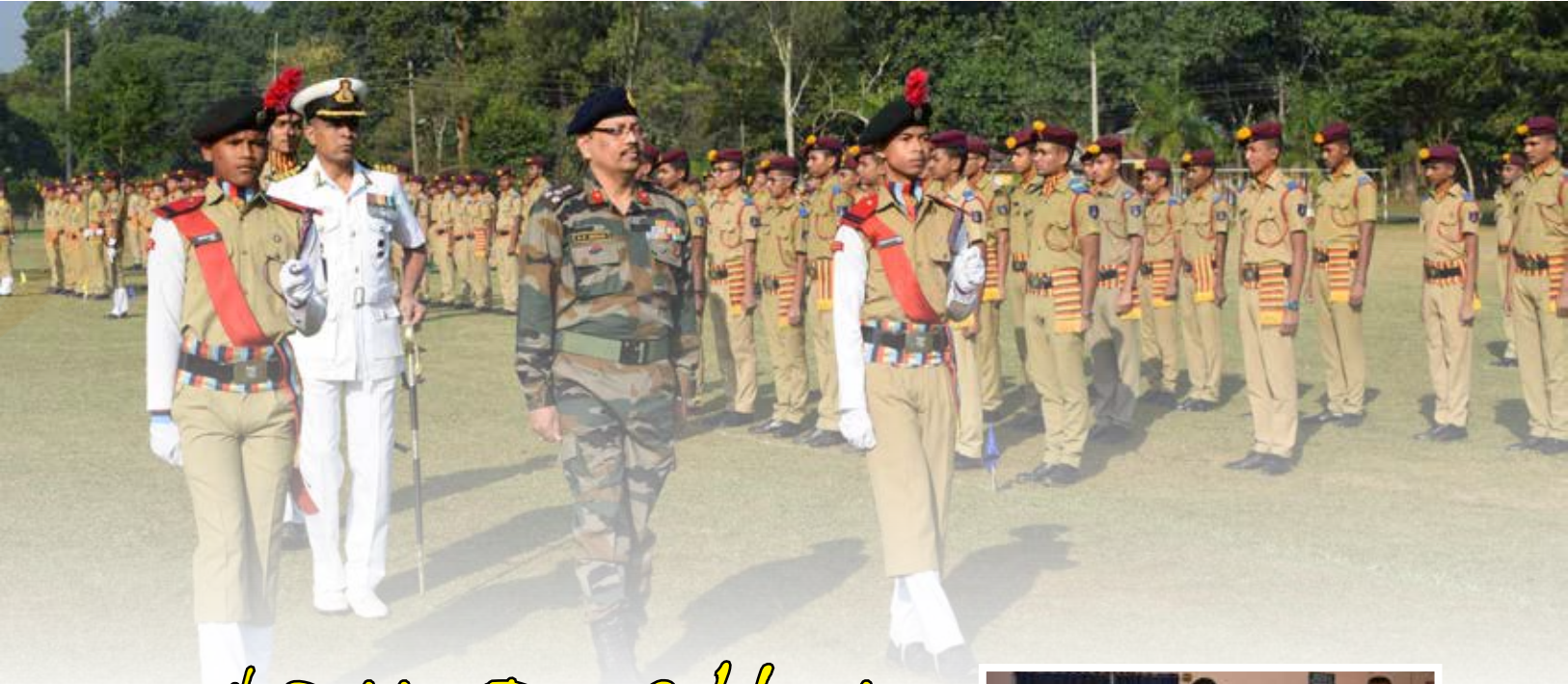

EDUCATION IN INDIA

- An Enigmatic Paradox

Lt Col MK Lenka is an alumnus of Sainik School Bhubaneswar. Commissioned into AEC on 08 Jun 1996, he has held various instructional appointments at OTA Chennai, AEC Training College and IMA, Dehradun. He had served as the Headmaster at Sainik School Goalpara and as an Education Officer in 57 Mtn Div. He holds a master's degree in English literature and M Phil in Education.

"Now, what I want is, Facts. Teach these boys and girls nothing but Facts. Facts alone are wanted in life. Plant nothing else and root out everything else."

That is Thomas Gradgrind from Charles Dickens' 'Hard Times'. Dickens compares students to that of empty pitchers with a lid on top. Then the school master appropriately named Mc Choakumchild goes on his business to take off the lid to pour into each pitcher from his boiling store of facts and figures, like Morgiana (more - ghee - ah - nah) in the Alibaba and Forty Thieves, killing outright the robber Fancy lurking within - or sometimes only maiming and distorting him!

Once upon a time India was the educational hub of the world with renowned institutions like Nalanda and Takshila. Adept at adopting we exchanged the ancient 'Gurukul' system of education where pupils stayed with the Gurus learning the lessons of life with an educational system propagated by **Thomas Macaulay** to produce a bunch of babus. Believe me or not, our present education system does that very efficiently.

There was a time when scoring 65% meant you are a top notch brilliant, and if you touched 70% then Einstein had better watch out! But today in the **mark-sheet centric approach** anything short of 90%, you get strange stares as if you are an alien from Jupiter. Paradoxically, while the college cut offs keep going up, our international standing in science, technology and innovation keeps coming down.

Post-independence India's literacy rate was merely 18.3%, and by 2010-11 it has touched 74.04% - male at 82.2% and the female at 65.5%. Under various articles of the Indian constitution, free and compulsory education is provided as a fundamental right to children between the ages of 6 and 14. Our school children fare very poorly when it comes to skill in reading, writing, mathematics and science. Globally we now stand 62nd on this measure, well behind even Jordan and Armenia.

In 2009, two states in India, Tamil Nadu and Himachal Pradesh participated in the International PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment) exam which is administered once every three years to 15 year olds. The result bespoke of the health of our education system - both states stood at the bottom of the table, beating out only Kyrgyzstan. While in the immediate aftermath there was a short lived exchange of verbal drumming over the quality of education in India, ultimately India decided not to participate again.

A few years back, picture of schools in Bihar, with well-wishers clambering over walls sticking their necks to the windows at exam centres like spider-men drew the attention of the nation. Further, there was Miss Ruby Rai, the topper in Humanities from Bihar spoke with a glint in her eyes that she studied besides English and Hindi a mysterious subject called '*Podigal Science*' which taught her how to cook.

The goals of learning according to UNESCO are **four**: Learning to **Know**, Learning to **Do**, Learning to **Be** and Learning to **Live in Harmony**.

Students and parents - do we honestly feel that we are anywhere near realising these ideals? We do celebrate Teachers' Day on every 5th of Sep. But sorry to say we have a very miniscule % of teachers who are dedicated to their profession.

Mumbai teenager 17 year old Malavika Joshi - doesn't have any conventional education - doesn't have a class X or XII degree but was selected for admission to the prestigious Massachusetts Institute of Technology, USA for being a three-time medal winner at International Programming Olympiad.

Is it not a paradox of our educational system? Some people are daring to facilitate their children to unlearn what they have learnt at school. Albert Einstein once said, '**Learning is experience, everything else is information.**' Thus ladies and gentleman, we need to facilitate - experience for the students not rote learning - to mug up, vomit it on paper and then forget.

I'd like to end my article with a quote from Nobel Laureate British poet and playwright TS Eliot, who wrote in the Poem 'Choruses from Rock':

*The endless cycle of ideas and action,
Endless inventions, endless experiment,
Brings knowledge of motion, but not of stillness;
Knowledge of speech, but not of silence;
Knowledge of words, and ignorance of the Word.
Then he goes on to write...
All our knowledge brings us nearer to our ignorance,
Where is the Life we have lost in living?
Where is the wisdom we have lost in knowledge?
Where is the knowledge we have lost in information?*

experts and academicians are coming together to popularise the SDGs and promote a better future for the nation. Quite a few noticeable amendments to the existing legal framework have been accomplished while several new schemes are being launched and activated. At the global forums India has presented reports about its efforts in implementing the agenda and received applause as well.

This new design is unique because of its comprehensive nature. For SDGs, poverty goes beyond the lack of economic resources to wrap the access to basic services and vulnerability to disaster; health is not about physical fitness alone, it encompasses mental well-being too; women empowerment is not contented in eliminating violence, it moves further to value unpaid care and having women as decision makers; similarly, building sustainable cities does not overlook the issue of living condition in the slums ■

We were joined by Mrs Gabriella Wright, French-American actress and also Mr Ibrahim El Kazaz from Best Delegate (a debate training organization), USA who were our trainers and resource partners. The NEIMUN 2018 was divided into three committees: General Assembly 1, General Assembly 2 and General Assembly 3. The delegates of these three General Assemblies discussed various agendas which included questions of Cyber-bullying, Natural Disaster Risk Reduction and Trafficking of Persons and Smuggling of Migrants.

The committees were - Social and Humanitarian Council (SOCHUM), Denuclearisation and Socio-Economic Council (DISEC), the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), the All India Political Party Meet (AIPPM) and the International Press Council (IPC). 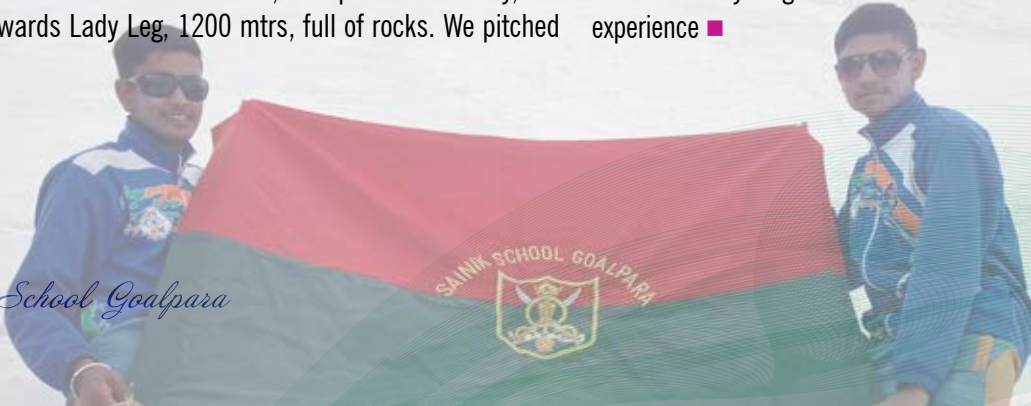
our tent there and stayed for one week. We visited Beas Kund where river Beas originates from. Also, we had snow and ice craft training and acclimatization walk.

The adventures which we had was really amazing and taught us many lessons on leadership, teamwork, determination, unity, being positive, change and being prepared for change and at last it taught us that "Everything is Possible". 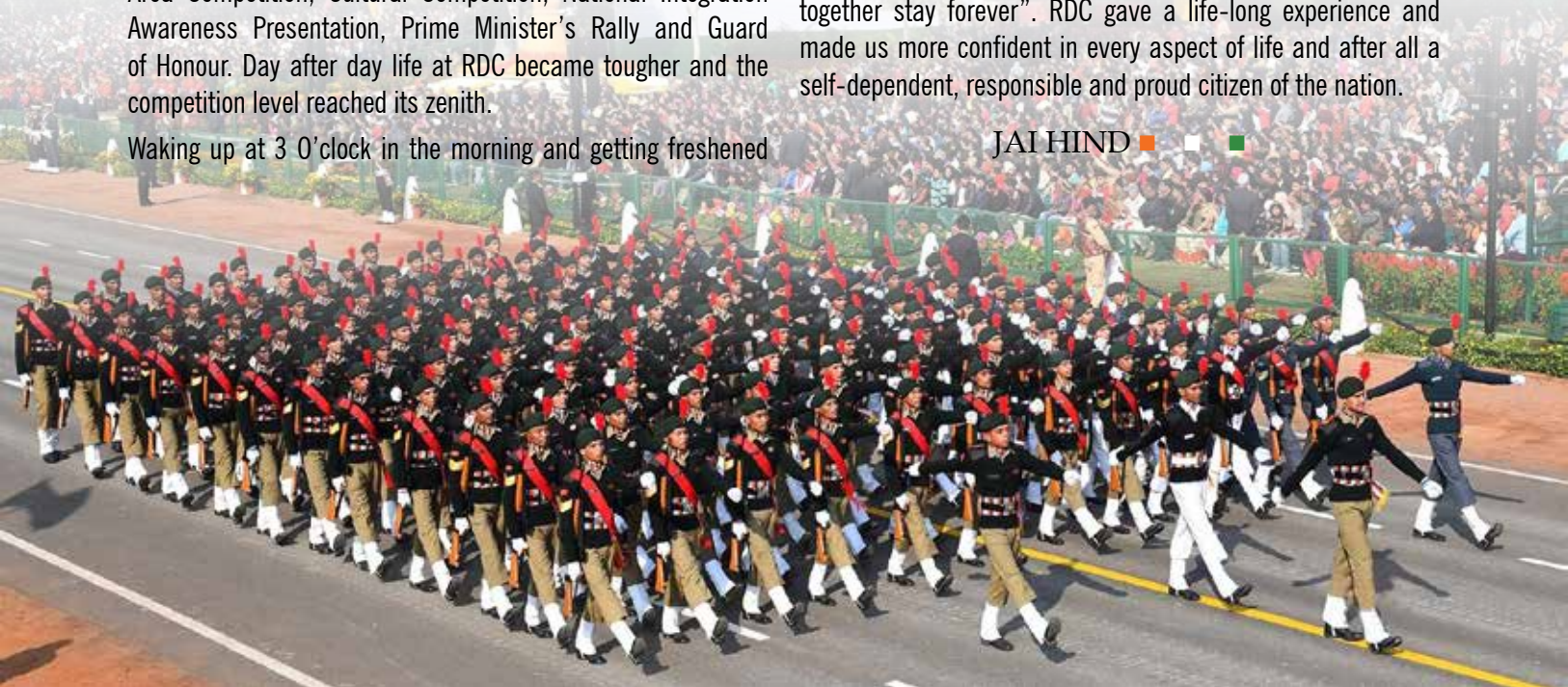
Waking up at 3 O'clock in the morning and getting freshened

ERA OF FIGHTER JETS

When Wright Brothers invented the first plane, nobody thought that it can be used for warfare. The idea of swiftly gliding through air and leaving behind a trail of destruction arose when the World War-I started. Days passed by swiftly and the world war was fought in 1940s 'by the silent killers from the sky' – the fighter jets.

As evolution continues by the laws of nature, development continues in the field of technological warfare. Nations were worried of fighter jets and the enthusiasts do build them rapidly to kill and to protect. It has been ages since the first bombardment was witnessed and the fighter jets evolved in such a way that nobody had ever imagined.

Today, we live in the age of 6th generation of jet fighters. Let's have a look on each generation :

- ➔ **1st Generation (1940-1950).** Jets were powered by turbojets instead of earlier piston engines. Eg.- Me262, F-86 Sabre, MIG-15 etc.
- ➔ **2nd Generation (1950-1960).** Jets of this generation travelled faster than sound and have on board radars and first air to air guided missiles. Eg: MIG 262, F-104 Star-fighter etc.
- ➔ **3rd Generation (1960-1970).** Avionics and interiors of fighter jets were improved to make

them multi-ride playing aircraft. These were installed with first precision munitions. Eg- F-4 Phantom II, MIG 25, Mirage F1 etc.

- ➔ **4th Generation (1970-1992).** Jets began to roll by using fly-by-wire controls, radars, weapons and manoeuvre abilities were enhanced and the first stealth jets were introduced. Eg- F-16, MIG 29, Mirage 2000, Tornado, F-117 Nighthawk etc.
- ➔ **4.5th Generation (1990+).** These jets had more advanced avionics and limited stealth features. Jets were able to move back in the air. Eg- Typhoon, Rafale, SU-35, FA-18 Superhornet etc.
- ➔ **5th Generation- (2000+).** Avionics were integrated with advanced sensors. Its stealth features met all aspects and air network was enabled. Their speed has been enhanced to 1800 mph. Eg- F-22, F-39, SU-57, J-20 etc.
- ➔ **6th Generation (2030).** Loaded with energy-directed weapons, ability to switch between pilot and auto-pilot efficiently, tear at hypersonic speed and transform their body into a car shaped or into a public vehicle. Eg - The Tempest.

I'm proud to say that our country India is not far behind in this field. Tejas, a 4.5th generation fighter jet, has been built indigenously in India by DRDO and India is also counted for having a wide range of 'DEVILS OF THE SKY'. ■

पृथ्वी खतरे में !

२ अगस्त २०१८ का दिन भी मेरे लिए एक आम दिन सा बीतने वाला था परंतु छात्रावास में अखबार पढ़ने के पश्चात जिसमें एक खबर छपी हुई थी जिसकी हेडलाइन - “कैसे डॉल्फिन तथा व्हेल जैसी मछलियाँ शोक मनाती हैं” को देखकर मैं अजीब सा रह गया। मैंने पूरी खबर पढ़ी तब उसके पीछे का राज पता चला।

बढ़ती आबादी बढ़ती मांग बढ़ते कारखाने - ये तीनों चीजों ने पूरी दुनिया में दंगा मचा रखी है। इस अनमोल पृथ्वी पर जब जन-जीवन का आगमन हुआ था उस समय के लोगों को इतनी सुविधाएँ नहीं थी फिर भी वे अमन-चैन की जीवन जीते थे। लेकिन समय की पहिया दिन-रात चलती रही नई-नई सभ्यताओं, व्यापारी धंधों का आगमन हुआ। सन १७५० में लंदन से जब औद्योगिक क्रांति सनसनी की तरह फैली तो मानो पूरी दुनिया विकास के पथ पर बिना लगाम के घोड़े की तरह हवा हो गए। नई-नई चीजों का आविष्कार हुआ तथा खोज हुआ जो हमारे जीवन को काफी ही सुलभ बना दिया। हम मनुष्य विकास के पथ पर अग्रसर तो जरूर हुए पर हमने अपने कर्तव्य को नजरअंदाज कभी न किया जिसके कारण हमें ढेर सारी समस्याओं का सामना करना पड़ रहा है जैसे - प्रदूषण, जानलेवा बीमारियाँ, बढ़ती तापमान इत्यादि इन समस्याओं का सबसे बुरा असर अन्य जीव-जंतुओं के साथ-साथ मानव जाति पर भी पड़ रहा है। प्लास्टिक तो हमारे जीवन का एक महत्वपूर्ण हिस्सा बन गया उसके बिना हमारा जीवन दुर्लभ है। शर्ट की बटन से लेकर अंतरिक्ष यान तक प्लास्टिक का उपयोग होता है। दिन-प्रतिदिन प्लास्टिक का उपयोग बढ़ता ही जा रहा है जिससे हर साल समुद्र में ५००-६०० टन प्लास्टिक कचड़े फेंके जाते हैं। अमेरिका के किनारे समुद्र (प्रशांत महासागर) में एक कचड़े की पहाड़ है जो इधर से उधर तैरती रहती है। हम जानते हैं कि वायु (ऑक्सीजन) सभी के लिए अत्यंत आवश्यक है इसी कारण से प्रकृति ने वातावरण में २१

ऑक्सीजन की मात्रा दी है। पानी में ऑक्सीजन घोलक के रूप में रहती है जो मछलियाँ अपने गलफरों के द्वारा ले लेती हैं। सोचने का विषय यह है कि प्रशांत महासागर में कुछ ऐसे जगह हैं जिस क्षेत्र में ऑक्सीजन की मात्रा काफी कम होती है जिसके कारण काफी मछलियाँ और जलीय जीव अपने जान दे देते हैं। यह सब प्रदूषण का प्रभाव है।

इस प्रदूषण ने हम मनुष्यों के लिए कई बीमारियाँ भी दी हैं - साँस लेने की समस्या (एम्पीसेमा, ब्रोन्किहाईटिस, फेफड़े का कैंसर) इत्यादि। यह बीमारियाँ हमें दिन-प्रतिदिन खाती जा रही हैं। दिल्ली, भारत की राजधानी, विश्व में एक ऐसे शहर के नाम से जाना जाता है जहाँ की प्रदूषण स्तर अत्यधिक है। वहाँ के हर एक निवासी को यह बीमारियों से ग्रसित होने की संभावना होती है।

प्रदूषण ने अंटार्कटिका तथा आर्कटिक जो सालोंभर बर्फ से ढँका रहता है अब वहाँ की भी बर्फ धीरे-धीरे पानी में परिवर्तित हो रही है जो कि एक चिंता का विषय है। इसके कारण समुद्र में पानी की ऊँचाई बढ़ रही है और समुद्र तट पानी में समाती जा रही है।

प्रदूषण अब हमारे पृथ्वी की सुरक्षा कवच - ‘ओजोन लेयर’ को भी दीमक की तरह चाटती जा रही है जिसके कारण पाराबैंगनीय किरण पृथ्वी पर अत्याधिक मात्रा में अपनी वार कर रही है जिसके कारण हमें त्वचा कैंसर होने की संभावना रहती है।

हमें अपने पृथ्वी को बचाने के लिए अपने कर्तव्य को निभाना पड़ेगा। हमें पेड़-पौधे को लगाना पड़ेगा और धरती को हरा-भरा बनाना पड़ेगा। हमें प्लास्टिक को धीरे-धीरे गुडबाय कहना पड़ेगा। हमे हमारे प्रधानमंत्री के द्वारा - “स्वच्छ भारत अभियान” मिशन में सुदृढ़ एवं सुचारू रूप से भाग लेकर भारत की नदियाँ - गंगा, यमुना आदि जैसे को साफ रखना पड़ेगा ■

प्रकृति का जवाब

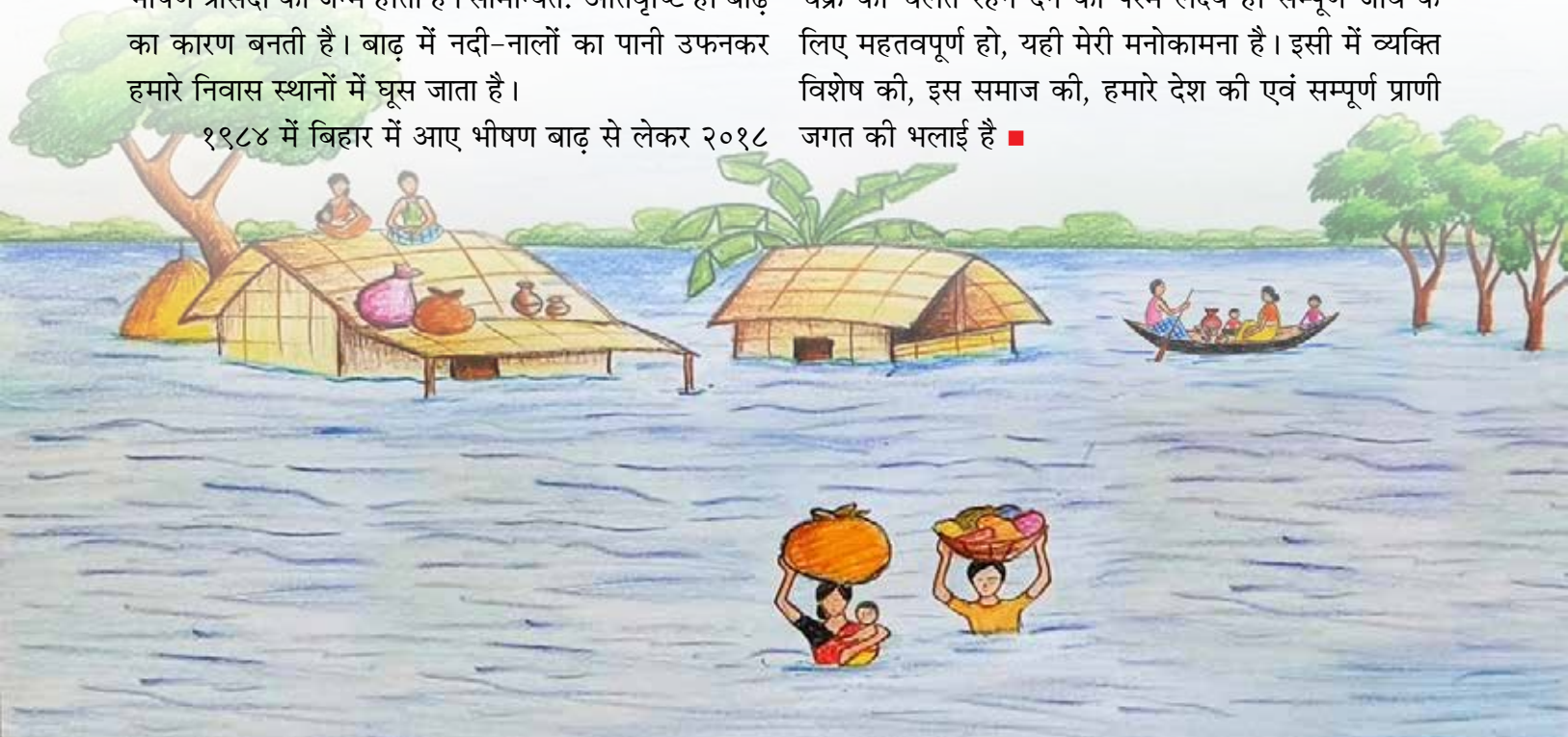
प्रकृति बड़ी ही निराली है। सृजन और विनाश प्रकृति की दो भुजाएँ हैं। एक ओर जहाँ सृजन के चमत्कार से प्रकृति जीवन और जीव के रूप में, कल-कलकर बहती नदियों के रूप में, फूलों के नदियों के रूप में सौन्दर्य को जन्म देती है। वही दूसरी ओर विनाश के क्रोध से प्राकृतिक आपदाओं के रूप में विपत्तियाँ ढाहने में भी तनिक मात्र संकोच नहीं करती है। प्रकृति में संतुलन बनाए रखने के लिए यह आवश्यक भी है। लेकिन यही बात तब बाधा बन जाती है जब प्रकृति का विनाशकारी रूप रौद्र हो जाता है। इसकी अनेको वजह हो सकती है लेकिन दो प्रमुख वजह हैं - पहला प्राकृतिक, जिसे हम रोक नहीं सकते, और दूसरा हमारी गलतियाँ जिनसे आदमी बाज नहीं आ रहे।

प्रकृति कोई भी रूप लेकर कहर बरसा सकती है। प्रकृति हमें गर्म लावे में पिघालने से लेकर बर्फ में दबाने का काम चुटकियों में कर सकती है। प्रकृति के इन्हीं रौद्र रूपों में से एक है - बाढ़। बाढ़ उस स्थिति को कहते हैं जहाँ धरती के सतह के ऊपर (खासकर मैदानी एवं निवासीय इलाकों में) अगाध जल का जमावड़ा लग जाता है। कई वजह हैं जिनसे बाढ़ जैसी भीषण त्रासदी का जन्म होता है। सामान्यतः अतिवृष्टि ही बाढ़ का कारण बनती है। बाढ़ में नदी-नालों का पानी उफनकर हमारे निवास स्थानों में घूस जाता है।

१९८४ में बिहार में आए भीषण बाढ़ से लेकर २०१८

में पूरे केरल को जलाशय में बदल कर रख देने वाले प्रचंड बाढ़ तक हमें हमारे करतूतों की प्रचंडता का ज्ञान कराते हैं। इन सत्तर वर्षों, अधिकतर बीसवीं एवं इक्कीसवीं शताब्दी, में बाढ़ ने लाखों लोगों एवं मवेशियों की इहलीला समाप्त कर दी है। भारत ही नहीं, ये बाढ़ प्रतिवर्ष सम्पूर्ण जगत की अर्थव्यवस्था, अवादी तथा प्राकृतिक बनावट को छिन्न-भिन्न कर भारी नुकसान पहुँचाते हैं।

SAINIK SCHOOL GOALPARA (SSG)

SSG, the first residential public school of its kind in NE was established on 12 Nov 1964 in Goalpara. It was inaugurated by Shri Sarat Singha, the then Honourable CM of Assam. The founder Principal was Lt Col DN Sahni. The school was shifted to Rajapara in 1976. The school is spread over 506 acres and has infrastructure to train 650 cadets. The school functions under the Sainik Schools Society under the Ministry of Defence.

SSG was raised to impart public school education to the boys of the region and prepare them academically, physically and psychologically for entry into the National Defence Academy. Appx 250 cadets have joined the armed forces through NDA entry and many others through other lateral entries. The school has produced five National Awardee teachers.

The motto is "Sarve Me Sadhyam" which means "Everything is Achievable".

HOW TO JOIN SAINIK SCHOOL GOALPARA?

Candidates (Boys for Class VI & IX) are to clear the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE) conducted every year. Selected candidates who qualify the written examination will be called for Medical Examination and Certificate Verification for admission.
